PROGRAM

The Help Our Students Program (HOST) was founded in 2010 by two local friends to help Ottawa students living in difficult financial circumstances stay and succeed in high school until they graduate.

If it were not for the help of the HOST program, I do not know where I would be. These students are working hard to stay in school but it isn't easy for them. In far too many cases, they don't know when their next meal will be, they wear hand-me-downs all through high school and, if they go out with their friends, they certainly can't buy anything.

Many need to either quit school to get a job to support their family or take on too many part-time hours that cuts the amount of time they have for school work.

I've been blessed to be able to use this money for small things like groceries for the house and big things like a new winter coat for my sister.

The HOST Program gives the students \$150 per month (September to June) sent directly to their own RBC bank account. It gives them hope that they may be the first in the family to graduate high school, hope to go to college or university, and hope to realize a long-held dream. It helps with family groceries, buying clothing for their siblings and going on school field trips.
